Napa Valley, CA (April 26, 2022) — Fine wine importer Demoire Estates is thrilled to announce their latest Import partnership with Domaine Roc de l'Abbaye of Sancerre. Domaine Roc de Chabaye is located in Saint-Satur, a village in the heart of Sancerre with winegrowing origins dating back to the 11th century. This strategic alliance coincides with a consistent and growing consumer

demand for the region's wines from its historic and critically acclaimed wineries. Demeine Estates is excited to partner with Domaine Roc de l'Abbaye, which joins a rapidly growing French portfollo that includes Domaine de Montille and Maison Legras & Haas.

"Domaine Roc de l'Abbaye's exceptional, historic vineyard holdings, coupled with its distinctive style and one of a kind terroir, makes it an exciting addition to our expanding portfolio," says Philana Bouvice, breenine Estates" President. "This prestiguious range of wines represents an important opportunity for our team and our entry into Sancerre, one of the most sought after wine recipions in France."

Saint-Satur is famous for its ancient Abbey and its Silex (flint) terroir on the hillsides bordering the Loire River. Silex is a coverted soil type, found in only 15% of the vineyards in Sancerre, that produces wines with amazing minerality, acidity and precision with tademark smoty, notes. The domaine has been helmed by the Mollet family for several generations. Winemaker Florian Mollet has been managing it since 2000, building a modern cellar and expanding the family estate to 42 arcses.

"I am delighted by the partnership with Demeine Estates and the ability, through the backing of this great team, to continue to develop our family estate in producing excellent

After studying winemaking in Dijon and working abroad in South Africa and Australia, Mollet returned to his family's domaine to hone his winemaking philosophy. Each parcel is vinified separately in stainless steel to maintain site specificity. The domaine holds 12 parcels total in Sancerne, with 24 acres of Sauvignon Blanc and nearly 4 acres of Piont Noir. Their parcels in Poully-Fumé are made up of nearly 15 acres of Sauvignon Blanc. The single vineyard wines and the antique range are age in barrels of 28 liters. The

wines are fresh and refined, with a distinct minerality that is indicative of the soil.

"The single vineyard bottlings and especially the Antique Cuvées highlight the intensity and depth provided by the old vines," said Lawrence Wine Estates Managing Partner Carton NECO," These wines deserve the same cellaring as great grand cru Chablis.

Demeine Estates will be importing the flagship monopole wine Roc de l'Abbaye Sancerre Blanc, the old vine L'Antique range such as the L'Antique Sancerre Blanc, L'Antique Sancerre Rouge and L'Antique Poullly-Fumé, and the Tradition Cuvées which includes Sancerre Blanc, Sancerre Rouge, and coulli-Fumé. Demaine Estates will also import the winery's elegant IGP Loire Sauvignon Blanc, grown in vineyards located on the slones of Saint'S atur.

"All Sauvignon Blanc aspires to the standards set in Sancerre," says Scott Diaz, Senior Vice President of Global Brand Strategy & Marketing, "Domaine Roc de l'Abbaye gives us coveted entry to the world's benchmark region, renowned for its Silex-rich soils, in a catebory where there is growing consumer demand;
