Domaine Roc de l'Abbaye 2022 Rouge Pinot Noir (Sancerre)

Dried herbs and blackberry open the nose of this savory wine that also dips its toe in a pool of black raspberry, black olive and strawberry stem. Graphite notes lead on the attack followed by cranberry and red cherry skin that contribute to a distinct tartness on the finish. Pair will potato soups, latkes and tofu stir fries. — $\mathbf{R.S.}$
